Pharmaceutical chemistry includes synthesis and identification of organic and inorganic compounds.Studying pharmaceutical chemistry allows students to contribute to life-saving remedies, enhance the speed of delivery of new medications, and help other.



Pharmacology lab consists of equipment to investigate the activity of various drug samples, such as Rota Rod, Electro-convulsiometer, Analgesiometer, Histamine chamber and Actophotometer.
